About the Evaluation:

Student learning evaluations include a review of the child's educational and relevant medical records. A comprehensive assessment is developed which is tailored to each individual child. A report on the findings, specific recommendations and a feedback session are also provided.

Consultation with teachers, attendance at educational meetings and follow-up meetings with the parents and school can also be arranged.

Evaluations are offered at a moderate fee, and insurance may cover a substantial portion of the testing.
